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The Department of Clinical Psychology is dedicated to training clinical psychologists in the practitioner-scholar model at the doctoral level.

Our students are trained to work in a variety of clinical and professional settings with a focus on cognitive behavioral approaches, empirically based assessments and treatments, consultation, interprofessional collaboration, advocacy, individual and cultural diversity, and serving the underserved.
